





The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe

NOVEMBER 21, 2021

Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe

On the last Sunday of each liturgical year, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, or Christ the King.

Pope Pius XI instituted this feast in 1925 with his encyclical *Quas primas* ("In the first") to respond to growing secularism and atheism. He recognized that attempting to "thrust Jesus Christ and his holy law" out of public life would result in continuing discord among people and nations. This solemnity reminds us that while governments come and go, Christ reigns as King forever.


During the early twentieth century, in Mexico, Russia, and some parts of Europe, militantly secularistic regimes threatened not just the Catholic Church and its faithful but civilization itself. Pope Pius XI's encyclical gave Catholics hope and—while governments around them crumbled—the assurance that Christ the King shall reign forever. Jesus Christ "is very truth, and it is from him that truth must be obediently received by all mankind" (*Quas primas*, 7).

For Christians, when our faith is repeatedly marginalized in public life, we can fall into the habit of compartmentalizing our lives. We love Jesus in our private lives, but we shrink from acknowledging the kingship of Christ in social life. When we celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King, we declare to the world and remind ourselves that Jesus is the Lord of the Church and of the entire universe.

Feast Day – November 20

841-869

An English patriot-king, Edmund began life with a Saxon lineage and Christian upbringing. He may have been elected king of East Anglia as early as 855, when he was 14, and of Suffolk the following year. He ruled wisely and was regarded as a good man. The great Viking invasion of 866, led by Ingvar, reached his domain a few years later. Because of his faith, Edmund repeatedly rejected Ingvar's attempts to have them rule jointly. Ingvar finally had him scourged, pierced with arrows and beheaded. Edmund is sometimes depicted in art with the wolf that allegedly guarded his head after his murder, and is the patron of wolves.


Fiesta - 20 de noviembre

841-869

Un rey patriota inglés, Edmund comenzó su vida con un linaje sajón y una educación cristiana. Es posible que haya sido elegido rey de East Anglia ya en 855, cuando tenía 14 años, y de Suffolk al año siguiente. Gobernó sabiamente y fue considerado un buen hombre. La gran invasión vikinga de 866, liderada por Ingvar, llegó a sus dominios unos años más tarde. Debido a su fe, Edmund rechazó repetidamente los intentos de Ingvar de que gobernaran juntos. Ingvar finalmente lo hizo azotar, atravesar con flechas y decapitarlo. A veces se representa a Edmund en el arte con el lobo que supuestamente protegía su cabeza después de su asesinato, y es el patrón de los lobos.






